Use of personal information

We process personal information collected via this website for the purposes of:

Information collected

We only collect personal information that is relevant for our stated purposes. Information about you, such as your name, your business telephone number, email and postal address, that is in the public domain (for example, on a website or public register). If you contact us, we may keep a record of that correspondence.

We collect information from visitors to this website through the use of online forms, email hyperlinks and every time we are emailed through the website. We collect additional information automatically about your visit to our website.

Legal basis to process your personal data

The GDPR allows personal data to be legally collected and used if it is necessary for a legitimate interest of the organisation, provided it is fair and balanced and does not unduly impact the rights of individuals.

Passing your information

Your personal data will never be passed on to any other party outside of Promail Limited, other than contracted parties acting directly upon our instructions, and in compliance with the GDPR. Cookies and site tracking

The Promail website uses cookies to enable us to improve our service to you.

Cookies are small text files that are transferred to your computer's hard drive through your web browser to enable us to recognise your browser and help us to track visitors to our site; this enabling us to understand better the products and services that will be most suitable to you.

A cookie contains your contact information to allow us to identify your computer when you travel around our site for the purpose of helping you accomplish your requirements. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but, if you wish, you can change these browser settings by accepting, rejecting and deleting cookies. The "help" portion of the toolbar on most browsers will tell you how to prevent your browser from accepting new cookies, how to have the browser notify you when you receive a new cookie, or how to disable cookies altogether. If you choose to change these settings, you may find that certain functions and features will not work as intended. The cookies we use do not detect any information stored on your computers.

We use tracking software to monitor customer traffic patterns and site usage to help us develop the design and layout of the websites. This software does not enable us to capture any personal information.

Data retention

As a Data Controller, we will only retain your personal data for as long as it is associated with a business in our database in relation to our services. Thereafter, we will anonymise your data by removing any identifiable information or erase it. Promail will verify our data periodically.
